1) Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 3:59 p.m. Those present were as follows:

2) Approval of Minutes

Zach Peters moved and Greta Mosher seconded a motion to approve the Board of Supervisors of Elections Meeting Minutes of July 12, 2022 and September 6, 2022.

3) Election Day Logistics

Chair Peters reviewed an updated schedule for Election Day on October 4, 2022. Updates included a physical layout of the polling location, drive-up voting, and election judge assignments and schedules.

The Board discussed the following additions to the Election Day schedule: an outside presence to increase election awareness, an added post office pick-up, and an added ballot intake session. The Board confirmed a review of same day voter registration procedures at the following meeting of the Board.

Additionally, the Board decided to not hold an election judge training prior to Election Day.

Clerk Reams announced that the Hyattsville City Council passed the Board's recommended amendments to the Hyattsville City Charter and Code regarding the addition of a third campaign finance report.
