1. Call to Order

2. Special Election Discussion

Clerk Reams confirmed the need to hold a special election to fill the Ward 2 Councilmember seat previously held by Mayor Croslin. The Board reviewed a draft election calendar and agreed to hold a vote-by-mail election on October 4, 2022, which ensured Prince George's County Board of Elections support prior to the November midterms.

The Board scheduled a virtual Candidate Information Session on Wednesday, July 27, 2022 with the Ethics Commission.

The Board then discussed upcoming moments for voter education and outreach, which included the following events: Summer Jam, Parking Day, and the Ward 2 Check In.

Greta Mosher moved and Erin Payne seconded a motion to hold a vote-by-mail Special Election on October 4, 2022 to fill the Councilmember seat in Ward 2.

Clerk Reams noted that the Ethics Commission was recommending the Council amend the Hyattsville City Code Chapter 8 Elections to revise the Annual Campaign Finance Report due date. The proposed amendment would increase transparency and voter accessibility to the report. The Board had no concerns.
