Construction update for HES

- Demolition is done! Dirt is still be trucked off site and sitework is continuing.
 - o Not as much complaints about truck traffic as HMS build. Overall number of complaints seem to be down compared to HMS.
 - o Some complaints about resulting rodent issues arising from demolition – no updates from PGCPs about mitigation measures. Last complaint was 3 weeks ago.
- Swing space update
 - o Access to school seems to be limited to parents
 - Any parents in school need to be volunteer approved unless you're having a 1 on 1 meeting with administration (this is an extensive process, PTA is trying to help parents complete this)
 - St. Mark's has access to the school building itself in the evenings and through the weekends which has resulted in challenges with the use of the space for after-school activities.

- There have been issues with supplies and school materials being disrupted/hidden/marked on – administration says this has been addressed with St. Mark's
 - Bussing has been challenging
 - Afterschool care has been challenging and is limited in availability on site due to shared use
- Concerns raised in Design meeting from school community:
 - Principal and staff want single user toilet rooms in each classrooms – say that it reduces bullying and lost instruction time. Requests have been met with resistance from design team – opportunity to escalate this through EFTF avenues?
